This language is not bad, but it won't work because it doesn't deauthorize the dam. The Corps counsel has determined that nothing can be done to the dam unless it is deauthorized. So, the proposed replacement of or modifications to the dam as written cannot be accomplished. I don't think it will allow the weir or something different to be done either. However, this language is somewhat better and addresses some of Mr. Simkins major concerns that he has raised to me...including that it doesn't allow any other alternative to be accomplished.

We will continue to work with the Corps to see if there is language that might alleviate some of Mr. Simkins concerns.
